



# HOW TO: Identifying Headsets for UC Desk and/or Softphone

This document will identify the frequently used headsets compatible with UC CISCO desk and soft phones.

**For Genesys Call Center Agents** looking for headsets specific to this platform, Genesys provides information on recommended headsets along with configuration instructions in the Genesys Cloud Resource center. This information is part of the actual call center software and is visible to anyone who uses the platform.

Headsets are purchased by each Agency following the agency's guidelines for ordering.

- **Agencies are not required to use SHI for purchases.**

## Headsets for UC Phones

**Selecting a headset:** Headsets for computers should have a built-in microphone and speakers. Since there are many setup options and technology changes quickly, UC Support recommends confirming with the vendor exactly which functionality, adaptors, accessories & features the headset requires to fit your needs prior to purchase.

- Headsets models are offered in 2 main types:
  - **Wired/corded headset:** The headset is always connected to the desk phone and/or computer. Users need the headset plus the amplifier.
  - **Wireless:** The user can walk away from the desk phone and/or computer and answer a call or continue on a current call. Users need a charging base plus the adaptor that allows the calls to be answered while away from the desk phone.
- Headset models also vary by design.
  - Monaural/Single (over the head & covers one ear)
  - Binaural/Double (over the head & covers both ears)
  - Over-the-ear piece
  - Some models are convertible and include over-the-head and over ear options


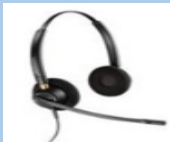
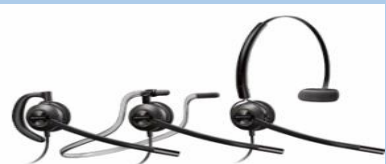



The desk phone headset models in the document will work with Cisco UC VoIP desk phone 7800 and 8800 series phones.

The soft phone headset models in the document generally work with most laptop models – some headsets require that the laptop has a lightning plug in.

**Some configurations such as VDI for office or remote access can impact whether these model headsets are compatible with your set up. UC Support recommends you work with CES on specific configuration compatibility questions.**



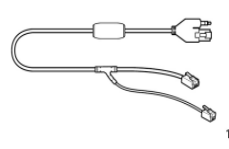
